WEEK 12: 1 John 5:1-5 DISCIPLESHIP THEME – The Victory that Overcomes the World!

This should be sounding pretty familiar by now! John must have been a trained teacher at some point in his life! Repetition!! The three main themes of the book show up again here: right beliefs, right practices, and right relationships! Or in other words, Jesus invites us to recognize He is God in the flesh, He calls us to follow him, and calls us to love one another! This brings us through to victory over the world and its unholy trinity (1 John 2:16).
