WEEK 13: 1 John 5:6-12 DISCIPLESHIP THEME – The Water and the Blood!

The foundation of our faith rests on Jesus Christ. John here reminds us that his identity as the Son of God is testified to by both the water and the blood: his baptism (ministry life) and crucifixion. The Spirit descended on Christ at his baptism, and the Father spoke his approval over his Son. Jesus is still God's approved source of life for us all!

Slowly read the daily verses below. Have these questions in the front of your mind as you again consider who Jesus is in your daily experience! Underline any words or phrases that stand out to you.

1. Why is baptism important? What did it mean for Jesus?
2. How was Baptism a way of life for Jesus?
3. How are Jesus baptism and his crucifixion related?
4. How do they form a firm testimony of who Jesus is?
